


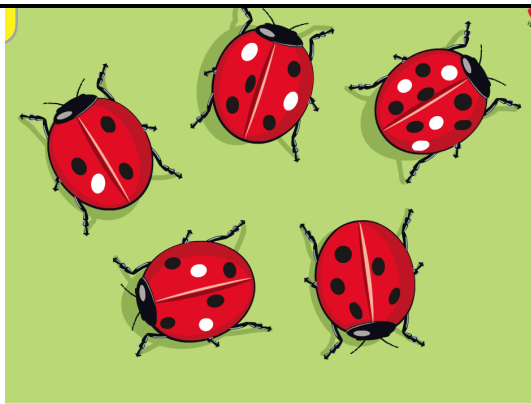

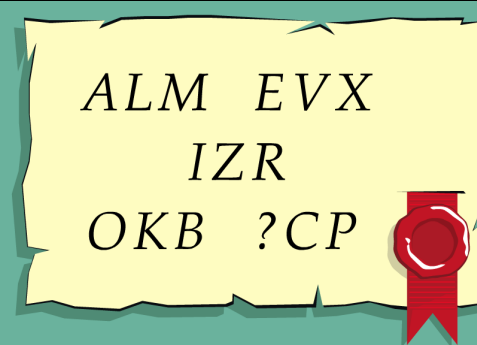

Extra tip: difference between black and white

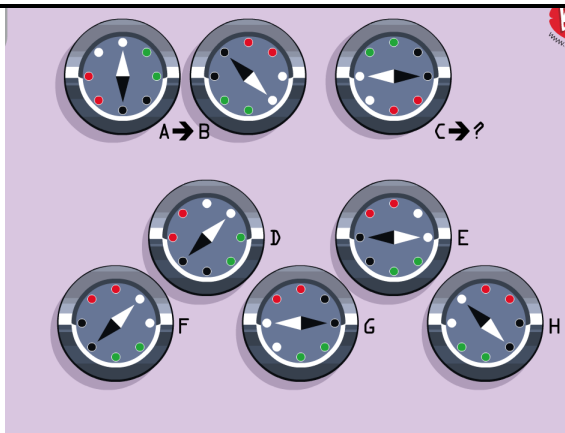

What letter has been replaced by a question mark?

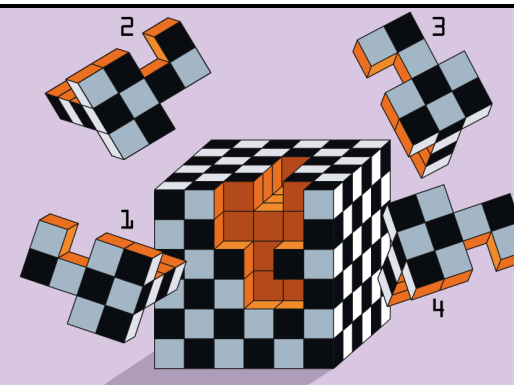
